Requirements:

1. Member must be in good standing of the chapter. Annual membership agreement outlines the requirements to maintain good standing, defined by Sealy FFA and approved by Principal.
2. A total of 15 pts must be accumulated during a student's uninterrupted FFA career is required to receive Letter Jacket.
3. Students must earn these points through participation in at least 4 of the 10 different divisions of the application.
4. Students must have participated in Sealy FFA Fundraiser each year of membership.
5. Students must have participated in Sealy FFA Community Service each year of membership.
6. Members meeting requirements will receive a packet with instructions on how and when to order through school campus.
 - 6a. These members will be able to order one Letter Jacket and one school patch which will be paid for by Sealy FFA. Any additional patches, additions to the jacket will be paid by the student.
 - 6b. If student has received Letter Jacket previously through athletics or other events, FFA will purchase one school patch/Letter.
7. An applicant must have the final recommendation of FFA Advisor / Agri-Science Teacher to be awarded letter Jacket.
8. If a student commits a serious offense as defined by SISD Student Code of Conduct, they will lose the privilege of receiving a letter jacket and may forfeit an existing Letter Jacket.
9. Application must be submitted before deadline established by FFA Advisor each semester.
10. This application and all updates will serve as the record of award if the applicant chooses to apply for the FFA Letterman's Scholarship.
